To Applicants of the Cadet Flight Indoctrination Program 2007

The Order of Daedalians is a fraternity of military pilots who encourage patriotism, integrity, and good character in our nation's youth. Each year, the Order sponsors the Cadet Flight Indoctrination Program which introduces highly motivated high school juniors and seniors and college freshmen and sophomores to the thrills and challenges of solo flight.

The Order of Daedalians is organized nationwide into flights which are usually named for pioneers of aviation. Daedalians in the San Antonio area are members of Stinsons Flight, honoring a local family of early aviators. You can find more information about the Order at www.daedalians.org.

The flight and ground training costs are covered by the Order and Stinsons Flight. You will be responsible for about \$200 in training materials such as aviation textbooks, flight regulations, pilot's log, aircraft handbook, etc., which will be yours to keep.

The application process is not difficult, but will require some effort on your part. Please complete the attached application as completely as you possibly can. Several sections require that you tell us of your ambitions and plans for the future. This is your chance to convince a selection board of active duty and retired military officers to select you as a candidate for CFIP.

Please note there is a requirement for a photograph. This does not have to be a professional portrait. A snapshot will do, but keep in mind you are making an impression on the members of the selection board.

You must include a current copy of your high school/college transcript. This does not have to be an "official" transcript as some schools will only mail official transcripts.

In addition, you will need at least one letter of recommendation. This should be from your Junior/Senior ROTC instructor or from your math/science teacher. You should tell them to include information about you that would convince the selection board that you are highly motivated to accept a challenge and deliver a quality performance!

Applicants will be notified if they are selected for an interview. Interviews will be conducted in mid-March at Randolph AFB with members of the Order of Daedalians.

Please send the completed applications to Stinsons Flight #2, P.O. Box 121, Randolph AFB, TX 78148, to arrive by Friday, 9 March 2007. The selection board will meet in late March. Selectees will be notified in early April.

This program will require a considerable commitment on your part. We will start training in early June—as soon as school is over for the year. You must be able to attend every training event and this will require your full-time attention for the month of June. Our objective is to provide you the very best flight training and your commitment is vital to achieving this goal.
